On March 4, The United States enacted a broad set of trade tariffs on imported goods from China, Mexico, and Canada. These tariffs impact a significant number of raw materials and finished products Sun Chemical imports into the United States from these countries.

The materiality of the cost impacts necessitate that Sun Chemical will implement a tariff surcharge.

Effective April 1, 2025, Sun Chemical will implement a 3.75% surcharge for all products and market segments.
